Payment

Once a quote is finalized and approved, an Invoice will be emailed to the client, with a 50% deposit required upfront. The Remaining amount is charged once the commission is completed. All payments are non-refundable, once the commission has been started. All rates are in AUD.

What you need to know about Copyright

All commissioned art is for personal use only. I own the rights to the artwork. The client may share an image of it on their social media platform/s however, the artist must be tagged and/or acknowledged.

A commercial license can be discussed and requires an additional contract and cost.

What is the Procedure?

It is important that the client provides clear instructions prior to the start of an Illustration. I will communicate regularly at the initial stages to ensure the concept and design is correctly understood. Major changes to what was initially agreed on may not be possible. However, if so, there will be an adjustment to the original Invoice. It can take from 7-21 days to complete a commission depending on the scale, medium and amount of detail. If you need your commission done by a certain date, make sure you advise of this at the beginning of our communication.

I share many of my commissions on my social media platforms and on my website once they're completed. Please notify me if you do not want me to share your commission.

Delivery

I am located in Sydney Australia and the artwork will be posted from here. Please keep that in mind when considering a completion deadline as shipping overseas can include delays. If you are local I can deliver the finished artwork in person.

Shipping price is normally discussed early on and included in the Original Quote.

How is the price calculated?

My rates are based on the complexity of the illustration, the medium used and the artwork size. In order for me to determine your rate, please be as specific as possible with what you'd like to have illustrated. The price can vary quite significantly.
